The workshop is organized within the Interreg CENTRAL EUROPE Project called TOGETHER (Towards a Goal of Efficiency Through Energy Reduction).

The TOGETHER project aims at promotion & dissemination of the concept of integrated energy management in public buildings, also by involving building users in the process and giving them opportunity to follow real-time energy consumption through the installation of smart meters.

During the event the participants will have a **unique opportunity** to get familiar with:

- holistic vision of a building, considering it not only as a structure but also a set of functions, processes and people using it;
- innovative concepts for managing energy in public buildings, involving **data analytics** and users **empowerment**;
- **innovative tools** developed within the TOGETHER project supporting active users engagement in energy management processes;
- practical cases related to the so called **Demand Side Management**, i.e. the modification of consumers' demand for energy through various methods such as incentives and education. Apart from listening to the inspiring presentations, the participants will have an opportunity to take part in the **networking session** with the representatives of project partners. Together they will discuss the best ways of motivating building users to engage in energy-saving efforts and of using smart metering systems to ensure this change.


